## Immigration Services

Invest in yourself, invest in your future! There are countless schools, colleges and universities in different provinces and cities all across Canada. ### OUR SERVICE

We will help you find a Designated Learning Institution (DLI) and program of your choice and make an application on your behalf. Once accepted to the school, we will apply for your immigration document authorizing the study.

### STUDY & WORK

You will be able to work part time (up to 20 hours /week during regular academic sessions in Canada and full time during breaks).

### PROSPECT

Most students are able to earn \$15,000 CAD or more per year while being a full time student. Study 8 month, work full time 4 months

### SPOUSE

A spouse can accompany a student studying at an eligible DLI with their own open work permit, if applicable

### POST-GRADUATION

Get a post-graduate open work permit for the same amount of time that you spent studying (earn on average \$35,000 CAD+)

### PERMANENT RESIDENCE

Many different paths to permanent residence for those who successfully pass Canadian university/college and get work experience in Canada

### MONEY

Must have:

- enough funds to cover 2 semesters of tuition (usually around \$16,000 CAD) but varies depending on the school and course
- enough funds to cover 1 year of living expenses, usually around \$10,000 CAD but varies with the province
